





SUBJECT: Availability of Portable Toilets on School Fields, Parks, and Public Places

This is in response to your memorandum dated August 26, 2003, regarding the use of portable toilets on school fields. The Department of Community and Recreation Services (CRS) places portable toilets at individual Fairfax County Public Schools (FCPS) sites that are available for community use through CRS. CRS provides portable toilets at these locations during the three outdoor scheduling seasons that run from March 1 through November 16.

During this same time period, school administrators at the high and secondary schools also place portable toilets near school stadiums and tracks to accommodate people attending athletic events. Generally, these portable toilets are removed during the winter months when there is minimal school use of the fields. The decision regarding how many, where, and how long portable toilets are placed at high and secondary school fields is made by the individual school administrators.
